PRE-K REGISTRATION

Primary and elementary schools in Wise County with kindergarten classes are now taking applications for the 2017-2018 Pre-K Program. Students must be four years old on or before September 30, 2017, to be eligible for the program. Parents should bring the child's birth certificate (or other proof of birth date) and income verification (tax returns, W2 forms, social security/unemployment benefits, or pay stubs) with them to the school. Students are required to be potty trained.

The Pre-K Program offers academic and enrichment experiences for four-year-old children that prepare them for success in kindergarten. Children who are accepted for the program will be attending school for the full school day each day school is in session beginning in August. Transportation is furnished by Wise County's regular school buses.
